



INSTRUCTIONS FOR SUN SCREEN ACCESSORY

Completely set up your Bungalow® Pavilion in the area that you intend to shade according to the owner's manual instructions.

Step 1. Hang the sun screen walls on the inside of the trusses.



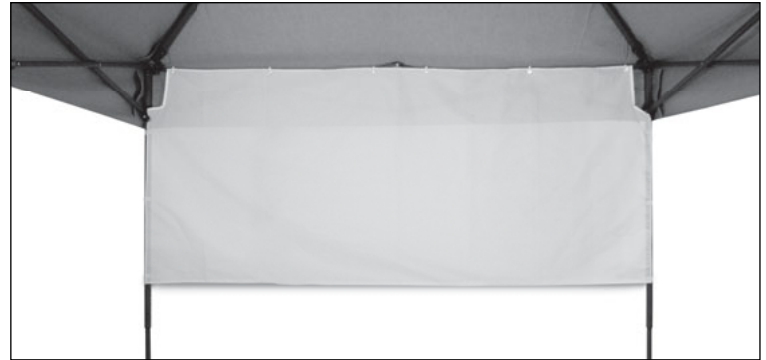
Step 2. Slip the hooks over the stainless steel cable.



Step 3. From the inside of the Bungalow Pavilion, wrap the quick attachment straps around the leg and secure. These are located at the midpoint and at the bottom of the sun screen wall.



Key Tip: If also installing a fabric curtain wall or corner curtain (as shown), the curtain wall should be placed on the outside of the sun screen.



Step 4. Sun screens can be used on more than one side at a time. Repeat the steps for each side.

Fabric Care:

- The sun screen fabric can be cleaned with mild soap (not detergent) and water. Let the fabric dry completely before storing.

Important Information:

- Always stake or weight down your Bungalow® Pavilion. Do not use in any potentially windy or rainy weather. Wind, rain and snow can damage the Bungalow® Pavilion and may also result in injury to you or others. Therefore, do not rely on the pavilion for protection in heavy or prolonged weather storms. Do not leave your Bungalow® Pavilion unattended.
- Do not use the pavilion in a lightning storm.
- The Bungalow® Pavilion is designed as a seasonal shelter.
- Ensure that all sidewalls zip together at the same time before installing anchoring devices.
- Keep all flame and heat sources away from the fabric top. Do not build fires within the pavilion enclosure.
